



Struthers City School District Elementary School Struthers, Ohio

The Struthers Elementary School is an 88,500 square foot facility constructed to combine four neighborhood schools under one roof at a cost of \$9.6 million. Goals of the design concept were to create smaller areas for young students grades K-4 to feel comfortable in this larger environment. Classroom wings were color-coded & patterned for way-finding, and the central commons, library, student dining and gymnasium act as the “town square” for the larger community. Passive security is achieved with clear lines of sight, permitting visual access to all classroom wings from a single central vantage point. Other features include an outdoor learning center immediately accessible from the library and all four classroom wings. Designed while partner with HSA.
